SECTION 5 – STATUS OF EXPLORATION PROJECT

Summary of previous work

The Sirmac-Clapier project is made up of 39 claims for a total area of 1,931 Ha, outcropping high-grade lithium hosted in spodumene-bearing pegmatites. The asset is located less than 3km from an existing high-grade deposit. Spodumene crystals at this site range in size from 1cm to 30cm, with an average of 10cm. The amount of spodumene found in the pegmatite ranges from 5 to 30% volume. Extensive mapping of outcropping pegmatite dykes has been undertaken by previous explorers. The project is in a favourable location close to a major mining town and airport infrastructure, with road and power infrastructure traversing the property. 178 rock samples were collected by Winsome, including rock grab samples and surface channel samples, 5-10 cm wide and 5-10cm depth cut with a diamond saw for 1-2 kg of sample mass.
